

Contained In/Contained Out Request

Facility/Consultant Process

- Submit formal written request (may be PDF document) to ADEM to include
 - Site History,(Processes, operations on site, anything to help us get a clear picture of site)
 - Site map
 - Specific Contaminant of Concern
 - Specific Code and media for which you are requesting a “Contained Out” determination
 - Specific quantity of waste covered by request
 - Analysis for each generation of waste (drum, well, etc.)
 - Plan for waste disposal

ADEM Process

- Review request for all required items
- Review analytical data to current Universal Treatment Standards (40 CFR 268.48) and RSL (link below) for all constituents listed for specific code in ADEM Admin. Code 335-14-2 Appendix VII
- Make determination for each drum, well, etc.
- Respond in writing with our determination. If a contained-out determination is made, the response should clearly state that the waste is still subject to a full waste determination (i.e. the waste may still be hazardous for something else)
- If Special Waste Profile submitted with request, it will be processed once the Contained Out determination is made (5 Day time frame does not apply during review of contained out request)

Please note: This is not a self-implementing policy. A written determination from ADEM must be obtained.
