At the beginning of each fiscal year, the Board will determine the average quarterly income for the prior year. The Alabama Department of Environmental Management will maintain a list of sites participating in the Alabama Drycleaning Trust Fund and will prioritize those sites based on potential risk to human health and the environment.

- After the deadline date established for each Board meeting, the Board Engineer shall prepare a list
 of sites that have requested authorization for funding to perform investigation or remediation work
 and list those sites in order of priorities established by ADEM.
- 2. The Board will only authorize expenditures <u>not greater than 75</u>% of the average quarterly income from the prior year.
- 3. Authorizations will be based first on priority ranking and second on date of receipt at the Board office.
- 4. The Board has the authority to modify this policy on a case-by-case basis.
